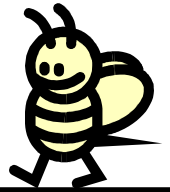

## 2009 Pool Season



The 2009 Pool Season is almost here:

- ❖ Opening day is May 22nd.
- ❖ Registration will be Saturday, May 16 between 9:00AM and 12:00PM and again on Thursday, May 21 between 12:00PM and 3:00PM. The registration form is in the newsletter or may be obtained at [www.baldwinparkhoa.net](http://www.baldwinparkhoa.net)
- ❖ New Key Card System
- ❖ Any child under the age of 3 or one that has not been toilet trained must wear a swim diaper and plastic liners whenever they are in the pool area.
- ❖ The pool is for the **RESIDENTS** of Baldwin Park. Remember only **one guest** per household.

Last year we had no incidents that required the pool to be closed and shock treated. We would like to repeat that this year, but it will again take the cooperation of all homeowners.

We will be using a new key card system this year. Unfortunately, there were problems with pool codes being passed around to non Baldwin Park residents. This year when you register for the pool there will be a required \$20 security deposit for the key card. If the card is lost, the security deposit will be forfeited to the Baldwin Park HOA. For an additional \$20 deposit, a new card will be issue. Note that only **one card** per household will be active at any time. At the end of the pool season you may return your key card for a full refund of your security deposit, or you may keep your card for use the following year.
